To whom it may concern,

The Indiana Soccer Association has been apprised of the proposed revitalization of Kuntz Stadium by SOK Global Sports. The proposal, which outlines a way for the facility to remain a soccer venue, is extremely attractive to Indiana Soccer, especially when viewed through the rich history of the 1987 Pan American Games. The proposed multi-use of the revitalized facility by soccer and rugby along with other field sports, is very attractive since both soccer and rugby share a linked heritage. It is also interesting to note that American Football's roots are also linked to rugby and soccer.

The Indiana Soccer Association with a current membership of approximately 60,000 members has robust outreach initiatives that target children who are currently without access to the "Beautiful Game".
