Over the past few weeks, we as an organization, Royal Irish Rugby have been in contact with SOK Global Sports regarding bringing Professional Rugby to Indianapolis and working with the City of Indianapolis Parks and Recreation department to rehabilitate the Kuntz Sports Complex on West 16<sup>th</sup> Street as a home facility.

- Royal Irish Rugby was established in 2000 as a high school rugby team serving the north side of Indianapolis. However, any player who does not have a high school team is welcome to play with us. In fact, the name Royal Irish is a combination of the HSE Royals and the Cathedral Irish. We were able to inspire enough players from HSE to start their own team. The Royal Irish have consistently won the State Championship, appeared in eight and won four National Championships. The Royal Irish have produced National Players including Captain Bryce Campbell and Olympian Joe Schroeder.
